# ICYMI – Quick Discussion – *Spirit of the Antichrist*

## What is the Spirit of the Antichrist?

- Opposition to all things that Christ stands for
- Opposition to the People of Christ
- Rising chaos, lawlessness, sexual perversion
- Right is wrong, and wrong is right
- Accompanies the Days of Noah at the End Times
- The Antichrist does not have to be physically appeared to us for this evil Spirit to manifest
- Rising Antisemitism and persecution of Christians

# ICYMI – 2021 Key Factors

- Spirit of the Antichrist growing rapidly
- "Church" continuing to fall away and follow doctrines of demons.
- Global Agenda
  - One World Governance – Health, weapons, military, climate
  - One world Church – Coalescing of faiths, lessening of distinctives, willingness to accept general framework distanced from Bible
- Peace in the Middle East...false and real
- Alliances of the enemies of Israel
- Military support of Anti Israel groups by Russia, China, and Turkey
- Lessening role of the US in the Middle East and around the world
- Signals of the Biden Administration ->

# ICYMI – Signals of the Biden Administration

- Immigration changes. Opening the borders to Migrants and Muslims
- Drilling and exploration changes to kill energy independence
- Cannot travel, shop, visit relatives in Assisted or Independent living without PROOF of vaccination
- Tariffs/trade restrictions on China and Iran loosened.
- Rejoining Paris Accords and Other environmental worldwide rules
- Continued pressure on churches to conform to the new “normal”

# ICMI – Signals of the Biden Administration

- Continued separation of the Wheat and Tares within the church body
- Continued movements within the “church” to form larger alliances to get us closer to the One World Church
- Marginalizing the 72 Million Americans who voted for President Trump in 2020.
- Using the Government to punish all those to disagree with them
- First Amendment Freedoms curtailed
- Second Amendment Freedoms curtailed

# I Corinthians Ch 10:1-5

*<sup>1</sup> For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were **all under the cloud** and that **they all passed through the sea.***

*<sup>2</sup> They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea.*

*<sup>3</sup> They all ate the same spiritual food*

*<sup>4</sup> and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.*

*<sup>5</sup> Nevertheless, God was not pleased with most of them; their bodies were scattered in the wilderness.*



# I Corinthians Ch 10:6-10

<sup>6</sup> Now these things occurred as **examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did.**

<sup>7</sup> Do not be idolaters, as some of them were; as it is written: “The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry.”

<sup>8</sup> We should not commit **sexual immorality**, as some of them did—and *in one day twenty-three thousand of them died.*

<sup>9</sup> We should not **test** Christ, as some of them did—and *were killed by snakes.*

<sup>10</sup> And do not **grumble**, as some of them did—and *were killed by the destroying angel*



# I Corinthians Ch 10:11-17

<sup>11</sup> These things happened to them as **examples** and were written down as **warnings for us**, on whom the culmination of the ages has come.

<sup>12</sup> *So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!*

<sup>13</sup> No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be **tempted** beyond what you can bear. But when you are **tempted**, *he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.*

## **Idol Feasts and the Lord's Supper**

<sup>14</sup> Therefore, my dear friends, *flee from idolatry.*

<sup>15</sup> I speak to **sensible** people; judge for yourselves what I say.

<sup>16</sup> Is not the **cup of thanksgiving** for which we give thanks a *participation in the blood of Christ*? And is not the **bread that we break** a *participation in the body of Christ*?

<sup>17</sup> Because there is **one loaf**, we, who are many, are **one body**, for we all share the one loaf

# I Corinthians Ch 10:18-22

<sup>18</sup> Consider the people of Israel: ***Do not those who eat the sacrifices participate in the altar?***

<sup>19</sup> Do I mean then that food sacrificed to an idol is anything, or that an idol is anything?

<sup>20</sup> ***No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God, and I do not want you to be participants with demons.***

<sup>21</sup> ***You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons too; you cannot have a part in both the Lord's table and the table of demons.***

<sup>22</sup> Are we trying to arouse the Lord's jealousy? ***Are we stronger than he?***

# I Corinthians Ch 10:23-30. The Believers Freedom

<sup>23</sup> ***“I have the right to do anything,”*** you say—but not everything is beneficial. “I have the right to do anything” —but not everything is constructive.

<sup>24</sup> *No one should seek their own good, but the good of others.*

<sup>25</sup> Eat anything sold in the meat market without raising questions of conscience,

<sup>26</sup> for, ***“The earth is the Lord’s, and everything in it.”*** (Ps 24:1)

<sup>27</sup> If an unbeliever invites you to a meal and you want to go, **eat whatever is put before you without raising questions of conscience.**

<sup>28</sup> But if someone says to you, ***“This has been offered in sacrifice,”*** then do not eat it, **both for the sake of the one who told you and for the sake of conscience.**

<sup>29</sup> I am referring to the other person’s conscience, not yours. For why is my freedom being judged by another’s conscience?

<sup>30</sup> *If I take part in the meal with thankfulness, why am I denounced because of something I thank God for?*

# I Corinthians Ch 10:31-33 to 11:1

<sup>31</sup> So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, *do it all for the glory of God.*

<sup>32</sup> Do not cause *anyone to stumble, whether Jews, Greeks or the church of God—*

<sup>33</sup> even as I try to please everyone in every way. For I am *not seeking my own good but the good of many, so that they may be saved.*

**11** <sup>1</sup> *Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.*
