Before we start the Bible Lesson

Last week I mentioned the three topics I added to give you an idea of what is happening related to Prophecy

- One world Governance
- Apostasy
- Middle East Events

Then we discussed Chapter 3 of Corinthians, here is a short recap

Recap of 1 Cor 3

- Each Christian has a separate call and responsibility
 1. Each serves his role for the Lord
 2. All are part of the same body, body of Christ
 3. Worldwide church (believers) are the body and mind of Christ
- Our “works” as believers judged by fire at Judgment seat of Christ...not salvation ... *but rewards*
- Finishes with a discussion of purity and holiness and deceiving ourselves. God Knows it all...*the good, the bad, and the ugly*

1 Cor Ch 4:1-5 The Nature of True Apostleship

4 This, then, is how you **ought to regard us**: as **servants** of Christ and as those **entrusted with** the mysteries God has revealed.

2 Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful.

3 I care very little if I am **judged by you** or by any human court; indeed, I **do not even judge myself**.

4 My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. **It is the Lord who judges me.**

5 Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait until the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of the heart. At that time each will receive their praise from God

1 Cor Ch 4:6-7

⁶ Now, brothers and sisters, **I have applied these things to myself and Apollos for your benefit**, so that you may learn from us the meaning of the saying, **“Do not go beyond what is written.”** Then you will not be puffed up in being a follower of one of us over against the other.

⁷ For **who makes you different from anyone else?** What do you have that you did not receive? **And if you did receive it, why do you boast as though you did not?**

1 Cor Ch 4:8-9

⁸ **Already** you have all you want! **Already** you have become rich! You have begun to reign—and that without us! How I wish that you **really** had begun to reign so that we also might reign with you!

⁹ *For it seems to me that God has put us apostles **on display at the end of the procession**, like those condemned to die in the arena. We have been made a **spectacle to the whole universe, to angels as well as to human beings.***

1 Cor Ch 4:10-13 A Rebuke

¹⁰ We are **fools for Christ**, but **you are so wise in Christ!** We are weak, but you are strong! You are honored, we are dishonored!

¹¹ **To this very hour we go hungry and thirsty, we are in rags, we are brutally treated, we are homeless.**

¹² We work hard with our own hands. **When we are cursed, we bless; when we are persecuted, we endure it;**

¹³ when we are slandered, we answer kindly. We have become the scum of the earth, the garbage of the world—right up to this moment.

1 Cor Ch 4:14-17. An appeal and warning

¹⁴ I am writing this not to shame you but to warn you as my dear children.

¹⁵ Even if you had ten thousand guardians in Christ, you do not have many fathers, **for in Christ Jesus I became your father through the gospel.**

¹⁶ Therefore I urge you to **imitate me.**

¹⁷ **For this reason** I have sent to you **Timothy, my son whom I love, who is faithful in the Lord.** He will **remind you** of my way of life in Christ Jesus, **which agrees with what I teach everywhere in every church**

1 Cor Ch 4:18-21

¹⁸ Some of you have become arrogant, as if I were not coming to you.

¹⁹ But I will come to you very soon, if the Lord is willing, and then I will find out not only how these arrogant people are talking, but what power they have.

²⁰ ***For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power.***

²¹ What do you prefer? ***Shall I come to you with a rod of discipline, or shall I come in love and with a gentle spirit?***
