In looking carefully over the history of the times, and the movement of the times, of which we have written briefly, this fact is apparent: that where ministers and Christian churches have held fast to the truth that the Holy Scriptures have been given by God as an authoritative and infallible rule of faith and practice, they have never wandered very seriously out of the right way. But when, on the other hand, reason has been exalted above revelation, and made the exponent of revelation, all kinds of errors and mischiefs have been the result."

1 Cor Ch 2:1-2

2 And so it was with me, brothers and sisters. When I came to you, **I did not come with eloquence or human wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God.**

2 For **I resolved** to know nothing while I was with you **except Jesus Christ and him crucified.**

1 Cor Ch 2:3-5

³ I came to you **in weakness** with **great fear** and **trembling**.

⁴ **My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power,**

⁵ *so that your faith might not rest on human wisdom, but on God's power.*

1 Cor Ch 2:6-10 God's Wisdom revealed by the Spirit

⁶ We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing.

⁷ No, we declare God's wisdom, a mystery that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began.

⁸ None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

⁹ However, as it is written (Isaiah 64:4)

“What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard,
and what no human mind has conceived” (understood)—
the things God has *prepared for those who love him*—

¹⁰ these are the things God has revealed to us *by his Spirit*.

1 Cor Ch 2:10b-13

The Spirit searches all things, even the **deep things of God**.

¹¹ For **who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them?** In the same way no one **knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God**.

¹² What *we have received* is not the spirit of the world, but the *Spirit who is from God*, **so that we may understand what God has freely given us**.

¹³ This is what we speak, **not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit**, *explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words*.

Let's do a quick recap

There are two ways of teaching.

- **Simple teaching** for the basics of Christianity. This is for the introducing of Christ to non-believers or instruction of new believers.
 - Teach with simple concepts (Christ and Cross),
 - Teach with fear of disappointing God,
 - Teach with examples of personal relationship with Christ
- **Deeper Teaching** for those **believers** who have moved beyond the baby food stage. Mature believers in Christ. Non-believers view them as foolishness
 - Teach the Wisdom of Christ by teaching the WORD of Christ
 - Understand that it is hidden from those who do not have the Spirit of God
 - Rely on the Holy Spirit and His Power to do it

1 Cor Ch 2:14-16

¹⁴ The person **without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God** but considers them foolishness, **and cannot understand them** because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

¹⁵ The person *with the Spirit* makes judgments about all things, but such a person is not subject to merely human judgments,

¹⁶ for,

“Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?” (Isaiah 40:13)

But we have the mind of Christ.
