In the Gospel of the Apostle John, there are many quotations from Christ using the Name of God...I AM. These provide a clear understanding of not only who Jesus is, but also who He claimed to be.

Verse	Attribute	Meaning
6:27	The Son of Man	This is a Messianic title used many times in the Bible that clearly identified Him as the Anointed One, the Messiah, the Christ
6:35	The Bread of Life	Depicts the sustenance of eternal life is found in Him. If we take Him in, like Bread, we will have Eternal Life with God
8:12	The Light of the World	In the darkness of the World, Jesus is the light, not just to us, but to all in the World
10:7	Gate for the Sheep	All must pass through Him to get to the Heaven, if He (& only He) passes you through the gate, you are through
10:11	Good Shepherd	Compare the deeds and attitudes of the Good Shepherd and the Bad Shepherd
11:25	The Resurrection and the Life	Jesus is the key to both resurrection for the believer and eternal life in Heaven
14:6	The Way, the Truth, and the Life	The Way to Eternal Life, the absolute total Truth you can and must believe, and the Zoe or eternal life
15:1	The Vine	All the grapes get sustenance from the vine, likewise all we have, will be, or will do is because of the vine of Christ
ADD	Other attributes	Meaning self apparent
8:16	Not Alone	Christ is not alone... neither are we. He is with us
8:18	One who bears Witness	We are also called to be witnesses (Acts 1:8)
8:23	From above, and not of this World	
8:24,28	I AM He (the Christ)	
8:49	NOT possessed by a Demon	
8:50	Not seeking glory for myself	
8:58	Before Abraham was, I AM	Speaks to the ETERNAL nature of God – No beginning, no End, the tense is Present tense because with God, time has no meaning. He always was, is and will be.
