





# The Parable of the Good Samaritan

Luke 10:25-37




**25** And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him (Jesus), saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?

**26** He (Jesus) said unto him, What is written in the law? how readest thou?





**27** And he (the lawyer) answering said,  
Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with  
all thy heart,  
and with all thy soul,  
and with all thy strength, and with all  
thy mind;  
and thy neighbour as thyself.

**28** And he (Jesus) said unto him, Thou  
hast answered right: this do, and thou  
shalt live.




29 But he (the lawyer), willing to  
justify himself, said unto Jesus,

And who is my neighbour?



**30** And Jesus answering said,  
A certain man went down from  
Jerusalem to Jericho,  
and fell among thieves,  
which stripped him of his raiment, and  
wounded him,  
and departed,  
leaving him half dead.



**31** And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side.

**32** And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side.



## Numbers 19:3-21

A person who did these things, or many other things, would be considered unclean.


- Touch a dead body
- Go into a place where a person was dying
- Be present when a person died
- Touch one slain
- Touch a bone of a dead man
- Touch a grave



## **B R I E F   H I S T O R Y**

- King Solomon died.
- 12 tribes of Israel were divided into 2 kingdoms.
- Southern Kingdom was the 2 tribes Judah and Benjamin.
- Called just by Judah. Jerusalem was the capital city.
- Northern Kingdom was the other 10 tribes of Israel.
- Called Israel. Samaria was a province and the capital city.
- Jews went into captivity.






The King of Assyria sent people from other tribes/cities to live in the land to maintain it. They brought with them their pagan idols. He also sent a Jewish Priest to them to teach them to fear the LORD God. And so they did. But, did not give up their idols. The Samaritans set up their Temple in Mt Gerizim in which to worship.

When Jews were allowed to return to Jerusalem, they would not let the Samaritans help rebuild the Temple, due to their paganism and uncleanness.



The Jews would not even walk through the Samaritan land, but traveled on the east side of Jordan to get to Jerusalem.

And so, the Jews and Samaritans hated each other.



**33** But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him,

**34** And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.



**35** And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.



**(In answer to the lawyer's question, "And who is my neighbor", Jesus asks the lawyer a question)**

**36** Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

**37** And he (the lawyer) said, He that shewed mercy on him.

Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

## John 8:48 Key to the Analogy

The Pharisees and the Sadducees were present and tried one question after another to test Jesus.

**48** Then answered the Jews, and said unto him (Jesus), Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil?

Jesus was born in Bethlehem in the Kingdom of Judah. He was taken for safety at a young age to Egypt until King Herod died. Then Joseph and Mary returned to Nazareth and raised Jesus there in the Northern Kingdom among the Samaritans. He spent much of his ministry in this Kingdom.
