1 Cor Ch 11:1-3 On Covering our head in Worship

¹ Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.

*² I **praise you** for remembering me in everything and for **holding to the traditions** just as I passed them on to you.*

*³ **But** I want you to realize that the **head** of every man is Christ, and the **head** of the woman (wife) is man (her husband), and the **head** of Christ is God.*

1 Cor Ch 11:4-7

⁴ *Every man who prays or prophesies with his **head covered** dishonors his head.*

⁵ ***But** every woman who prays or prophesies with her **head uncovered** dishonors her head—it is the same as having her head shaved.*

⁶ *For if a woman does not cover her head, she might as well have her hair cut off; **but if it is a disgrace** for a woman to have her hair cut off or her head shaved, then she should cover her head.*

Trump at Wailing Wall

- *Yarmulke or Kippah*
- As many styles as you can image. The “look” tells us about the wearer

1 Cor Ch 11:4-12

⁴ Every man who prays or prophesies with his head covered dishonors his head.

⁵ But every woman who prays or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonors her head—it is the same as having her head shaved.

⁶ For if a woman does not cover her head, she might as well have her hair cut off; but if it is a disgrace for a woman to have her hair cut off or her head shaved, then she should cover her head.

⁷ A man **ought not** to cover his head, since he is the image and glory of God; ***but woman is the glory of man.***

⁸ For man did not come from woman, but woman from man;

⁹ neither was man created for woman, but woman for man.

¹⁰ *It is for this reason that a woman ought to have authority over her own head, because of the angels.*

¹¹ Nevertheless, in the Lord woman is not independent of man, nor is man independent of woman.

¹² ***For as woman came from man, so also man is born of woman. But everything comes from God.***

1 Cor Ch 11:13-16

¹³ Judge for yourselves: Is it proper for a woman to pray to God with her head uncovered?

¹⁴ Does not the very nature of things teach you that if a man has long hair, it is a disgrace to him,

¹⁵ but that if a woman has long hair, it is her glory? For long hair is given to her as a covering.

¹⁶ *If anyone wants to be contentious about this, we have no other practice—nor do the churches of God.*

Verse from NASB is clearer

¹⁶ But if anyone is inclined to be contentious, we have no such practice, nor have the churches of God.

Now I know this is crystal clear to all of you



1 Cor Ch 11:17-22 Abuses of the Lords Supper

*17 In the following directives **I have no praise for you**, for your meetings do more harm than good.*

*18 In the first place, **I hear** that when you come together as a church, there are divisions among you, and to some extent I believe it.*

19 No doubt there have to be differences among you to show which of you have God's approval.

*20 So then, when you come together, it is **not** the Lord's Supper you eat,*

21 for when you are eating, some of you go ahead with your own private suppers. As a result, one person remains hungry, and another gets drunk.

*22 Don't you have homes to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God by humiliating those who have nothing? **What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you? Certainly not in this matter!***

1 Cor Ch 11:23-26

²³ For I **received from the Lord** what I also passed on to you: *The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,*

²⁴ *and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.”*

²⁵ *In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.”*

²⁶ *For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.*

1 Cor 11:27-32

²⁷ So then, *whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.*

²⁸ Everyone ought to *examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink from the cup.*

²⁹ *For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves.*

³⁰ That is why many among you are weak and sick, and a number of you have fallen asleep.

³¹ But if we were more discerning with regard to ourselves, we would not come under such judgment.

³² *Nevertheless, when we are judged in this way by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will not be finally condemned with the world.*

1 Cor 11:33-34

³³ So then, my brothers and sisters, when you gather to eat, you should all eat together.

³⁴ Anyone who is hungry should eat something at home, so that when you meet together it may not result in judgment.
