# 1 Corinthians Ch 5:12-13

*<sup>12</sup> What business is it of mine to judge those **outside** the church? **Are you not to judge those inside?***

*<sup>13</sup> God will judge those outside.*

*“Expel the wicked person from among you.”*

***Think about that and why we need to do that***

# 1 Cor Ch 6 General Discussion

Why was this a problem in Corinth

- Mostly Greek and Pagan background
- Moral looseness in all the Roman Empire/ Greece
- Paul needed to address 3 issues
  1. The True Rank of Christians Eternally
  2. Their attitudes towards each other (Other Brothers/Sisters)
  3. Their Character in relation to Gods standards for righteousness

# 1 Cor Ch 6:1-3 Lawsuits among believers

**6** If any of you has a **dispute** with **another**, do you **dare** to take it before the ungodly for judgment instead of before the Lord's people?

**2** Or **do you not know** that the **Lord's people will judge the world**? And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge *trivial cases*?

**3** **Do you not know** that **we will judge angels**? *How much more the things of this life!*

# 1 Cor Ch 6:4-6

<sup>4</sup> Therefore, if you have disputes about such matters, **do you ask for a ruling from those whose way of life is scorned in the church?**

<sup>5</sup> **I say this to shame you.** *Is it possible that there is nobody among you wise enough to judge a dispute between believers?*

<sup>6</sup> But instead, **one brother takes another to court—**  
*and this in front of unbelievers!*



# 1 Cor Ch 6:7-8

<sup>7</sup> The very fact that you **have** lawsuits among you means *you have been completely defeated already.*  
*Why not rather be wronged? Why not rather be cheated?*

<sup>8</sup> Instead, **you yourselves cheat** and do wrong, and **you do this to your brothers and sisters.**

# 1 Cor Ch 6:9-11

<sup>9</sup> Or **do you not know** that wrongdoers will not inherit the kingdom of God? **Do not be deceived:** Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor men who have sex with men

<sup>10</sup> nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>11</sup> *And that is what some of you were.* **But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God**

# 1 Cor Ch 6:12-13 Rights and Responsibilities

<sup>2</sup> “I have the **right** to do anything,” you say—*but not everything is beneficial*. “I have the **right** to do anything” —*but I will not be mastered by anything*.

<sup>13</sup> You say, “*Food for the stomach and the stomach for food, and God will destroy them both.*” **The body, however, is not meant for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body.**

# 1 Cor Ch 6:14-17

<sup>14</sup> *By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also.*

<sup>15</sup> **Do you not know** that **your bodies are members of Christ himself?** *Shall I then take the members of Christ and unite them with a prostitute? **Never!***

<sup>16</sup> **Do you not know** that he who unites himself with a prostitute is **one with her in body?** For it is said, *“The two will become one flesh.”*

<sup>17</sup> But *whoever is united with the Lord is one with him in spirit.*

# 1 Cor Ch 6:18-20

<sup>18</sup> *Flee from sexual immorality.* All other sins a person commits are outside the body, **but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body.**

<sup>19</sup> **Do you not know** that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? *You are not your own;*

<sup>20</sup> you were bought at a price. *Therefore honor God with your bodies.*
