I want to return to one passage from Ch 9:16-17

16 "No one sews a patch of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch will pull away from the garment, making the tear worse.

17 Neither do people pour new wine into old wineskins. If they do, the skins will burst; the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. No, they pour new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

What is Jesus saying here?

Matt Ch 9:19-22 Healing of Leaders daughter and sick woman

18 While he was saying this, a synagogue leader came and knelt before him and said, “My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live.”

19 Jesus got up and went with him, and so did his disciples.

20 Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak.

21 She said to herself, “If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed.”

22 Jesus turned and saw her. “Take heart, daughter,” he said, “your faith has healed you.” And the woman was healed at that moment.

Luke 8: 40-47 Woman healed

40 Now when Jesus returned, a crowd welcomed him, for they were all expecting him.

*41 Then a man named **Jairus**, a synagogue leader, came and fell at Jesus' feet, pleading with him to come to his house*

42 because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying.

As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him.

*43 And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years, **but no one could heal her.***

*44 She came up **behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped.***

*45 **"Who touched me?"** Jesus asked.*

*When they all denied it, Peter said, **"Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you."***

*46 But Jesus said, **"Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me."***

47 Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed.

*48 Then he said to her, **"Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace."***

Luke 8:49-56 The Daughter raised to life

*49 While Jesus was still speaking, someone came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. **“Your daughter is dead,”** he said. **“Don’t bother the teacher anymore.”***

*50 Hearing this, Jesus said to Jairus, **“Don’t be afraid; just believe, and she will be healed.”***

*51 When he arrived at the house of Jairus, he did not let anyone go in with him except **Peter, John and James,** and the **child’s father and mother.***

*52 Meanwhile, all the people were wailing and mourning for her. **“Stop wailing,”** Jesus said. **“She is not dead but asleep.”***

*53 **They laughed at him, knowing that she was dead.***

*54 But he took her by the hand and said, **“My child, get up!”***

*55 Her **spirit returned,** and at once she stood up. Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat. **56 Her parents were astonished, but he ordered them not to tell anyone what had happened.***

Matt 9:27-34 Jesus Heals the blind and Mute

*27 As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, “**Have mercy on us, Son of David!**”*

*28 When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, “**Do you believe that I am able to do this?**”*

*“**Yes, Lord,**” they replied.*

*29 Then he touched their eyes and said, “**According to your faith let it be done to you**”;*

*30 and their sight was restored. Jesus warned them sternly, “**See that no one knows about this.**”*

*31 **But** they went out and spread the news about him all over that region.*

32 While they were going out, a man who was demon-possessed and could not talk was brought to Jesus.

*33 And when the demon was driven out, the man who had been mute spoke. The crowd was amazed and said, “**Nothing like this has ever been seen in Israel.**”*

*34 But the Pharisees said, “**It is by the prince of demons that he drives out demons.**”*

Matt 9: 35-38 The workers are few...

35** Jesus went through all the towns and villages, **teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.

36** When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because **they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

37** Then he said to his disciples, **“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.

***38** Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”*

Matt 10:1-4 Jesus calls His Twelve

10 Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness.

2 These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon (who is called Peter) and his brother Andrew; James son of Zebedee, and his brother John; 3 Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; 4 Simon the Zealot and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him.

Matt 10:5-15 *Go with these Instructions...*

⁵ *These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: “Do not go among the Gentiles or enter any town of the Samaritans.*

⁶ *Go rather to the lost sheep of Israel.*

⁷ *As you go, proclaim this message: ‘**The kingdom of heaven has come near.**’*

⁸ *Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. **Freely you have received; freely give.***

⁹ *“Do not get any gold or silver or copper to take with you in your belts—*

¹⁰ *no bag for the journey or extra shirt or sandals or a staff, for the worker is worth his keep.*

¹¹ *Whatever town or village you enter, search there for some worthy person and stay at their house until you leave.*

¹² *As you enter the home, give it your greeting.*

¹³ *If the home is deserving, let your peace rest on it; if it is not, let your peace return to you.*

¹⁴ ***If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, leave that home or town and shake the dust off your feet.***

¹⁵ ***Truly I tell you, it will be more bearable for Sodom and Gomorrah on the day of judgment than for that town.***
